Day 7 | Rest & Acclimatisation in Namche Bazaar 3440m

We take a rest and acclimatisation day in Namche. Several impressive side treks are available, including to the Everest View Hotel (3880m) for stunning views of Everest, and a host of Himalayan peaks. **BLD**

Day 8 | Phortse Tenga 3680m

Trek to our lunch spot at Mong La. From here trail descends to our lodge at Phortse Tenga beside the Dudh Kosi River. **BLD**

Day 9 | Dole 4090m

Another short day to assist in acclimatisation. The trail climbs to the small settlement of Dole in time for lunch. In the afternoon there will be a short walk to assist acclimatisation. **BLD**

Day 10 | Machhermo 4410m Ascend the Gokyo Valley to Machhermo

Village. In the afternoon there will be a short walk to assist acclimatisation. **BLD**

Day 11 | Gokyo 4750m

Trek to the settlement of Gokyo. We pass three lakes to reach our lodge on the shore of the third lake, called Dudh Pokhari. **BLD**

from here rank with any that trekkers may encounter in Nepal. We get memorable views of four 8,000m peaks – Everest, Cho Oyu, Lhotse and Makalu plus the 3 sacred lakes to the south. We return to our lodge for lunch. The afternoon is free to relax. **BLD**

Day 13 | Exploration Day in the Gokyo Vallev

After an early breakfast we will head north up beside the Ngozumba Glacier. Our aim is to reach the fifth lake (4975m). There are outstanding views of Mt Everest and other peaks from here. We will take a packed lunch today and return to Gokyo by midafternoon.

Day 14 | Marulung Via Renjo La 4200m

It will take about 3 hours to reach Renio La. The glorious views from the pass include Mt Everest. After the pass, head down the Bhote Kosi Valley. Pass yak grazing areas to reach our lodge at Marulung. **BLD**

Dav 15 | Namche Bazaar 3440m Descend the Bhote Kosi Valley. After reaching the picturesque village of Thame we stop in a comfortable lodge for an early lunch. Reach

Day 16 | Spare Day

Day 17 | Phakdingma 2640m

From Namche the trail descends rapidly to the floor of the Dudh Kosi Valley before reaching our lodge at Phakdingma. **BLD**



Dav 3 | Ushuaia


